
Congratulations on a good job with the "Universe of Star Trek" documentaries. Much appreciated the cassette you sent us and a group of old Star Trek folk sat around in the office last night and ran all seventeen episodes, enjoying them hugely.

If you do decide to make future episodes, you might consider some other interesting Star Trek people for interviews. One of these is Bob Justman who was Associate Producer for the first year and a half and Co-Producer the last year and a half.
